

Black Mountain Uphill Climb



Rules and Regulations:

This rule book is not intended to be all inclusive. Other judgments may be made by event organizers and judges as circumstances warrant. Judges decisions are final.

- Registration: Racers may register sleds in as many classes as they would like as long as **the sled falls below the engine class specified.**
 - For example: a racer on a 600cc sled may race in the classifications for sled up to 699cc **and** the classification for sled up to 800cc but not in the classification for sleds up to 500cc
 - Any non-stock or modified sled must run in the open class only. Judges will make the final decision should there be questions about whether a sled races in the stock or open class.
- All racers must do the following before racing
 - Read and understand all event rules and regulations
 - Complete the registration form for each race they intend on competing in
 - Complete and sign the liability release form
 - Pay all required racers registration fees.
- All racers are required to have rider insurance

RACE FORMAT:

The format for the race will be uphill, slalom style, timed drags. One racer will be on course at a time. The race consists of two runs. All racers will complete their first runs before the second runs are started.

- Running orders will be compiled based on the order in which registrations are received.
 - Running order will be reversed for the second run.
 - Best combined time (for 2 runs) in each class wins.
 - Racers must post 2 times to place in that evenings event.
- Bibs will be issued to racers. Racers are responsible for returning their bibs at the completion of their second run or they will be charged \$50 for replacement costs of the bib.
- If a racer intends on running 2 sleds in the same classification he/she will need to have 2 bibs.
- Only racers and race personnel will be allowed in the pit and staging areas.
- Racers not in position at the staging area when it is there time to run will miss their run. No refunds will be given for missed starts.
- Timers – Racers are not allowed around the timing locations. Timers are not allowed to give out times. Racers distracting timers will be disqualified. Results will be published as soon as timing officials have compiled them.
- Timing Equipment – Any racer hitting the timing equipment or lights will be disqualified for the rest of the event. The racer will be billed for the repair cost.
- A 15 second penalty will be assessed for each occurrence if racers contact the gates/barrels on the slalom course.
- Racers injured during the event are required to report the injury to Black Mountain Ski Patrol before the end of the event.

- All racers must stay in the defined pit area, staging area or on course. Access to other parts of the ski area is forbidden. These rules will be strictly enforced and those violating these rules will forfeit the race and be asked to leave the premises (no refund will be given). Speed limit in the pits and staging area is limited to 10mph.
- When returning from the top of the course to the staging areas all sleds must stay on the defined return trail. Speed is limited to 25 mph on this trail. Failure to comply will result in forfeiting the race and the racer will be asked to leave the premises (no refund will be given).
- Points Champion-at the end of the 3rd hill climb, first place trophies will be awarded to the points champion in each class.
- Points will be awarded as follows:
